

FACTS**WHAT DOES MISSION LANE LLC DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?****Why?**

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and income
- account balances and payment history
- credit history and credit scores

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Mission Lane LLC chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

Who is providing this notice?	Mission Lane LLC, the servicing agent for the bank that issues your card.
What we do	
How does Mission Lane LLC protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Mission Lane LLC collect my personal information?	<p>We collect your personal information, for example, when you:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Apply for a card or give your income information ■ Provide account information or give us your contact information ■ Use your card <p>We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus or other companies.</p>
Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness ■ Affiliates from using your information to market to you ■ Sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you <p>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.</p>
Definitions	
Affiliates	<p>Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ <i>Mission Lane LLC does not share with its affiliates.</i>
Nonaffiliates	<p>Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ <i>Mission Lane LLC does not share with nonaffiliates so they can market to you.</i>
Joint marketing	<p>A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ <i>Mission Lane LLC is a service provider to the bank that issues your credit card, pre-paid debit card, or other financial product, and provides marketing services.</i>
Other important information	
<p>AZ Residents: Mission Lane LLC does business in Arizona under the trade name Mission Lane Card Services LLC.</p> <p>CA Residents: We will not share your information with nonaffiliates except in the manner disclosed above or with your consent, as permitted by law.</p> <p>VT Residents only: We will not share information we collect about Vermont residents with companies outside of Mission Lane LLC, except as permitted by Vermont law, or the Vermont resident consents. For example, in connection with your prepaid debit card application and account, we share your information with the applicable issuing bank, which is a financial institution with whom we have entered into a joint marketing agreement.</p> <p>NV Residents: We are providing you this notice under state law.
